Day 13 Friday 10 May

Venice to Verona & Lake Garda

Depart Venice after breakfast for the historic centre of Verona. Lake Garda to Stresa

After breakfast you continue to the famous lakes district and to grand and gorgeous Stresa on the shores of Lake Maggiore. Tour Villa Taranto in Pallanza enroute, one of northern Italy's most scenic villas, then check in to your wonderful Art Nouveau hotel for the next four nights. Stresa & the Islands

Your touring includes the gardens at Villa Melzi where beautiful sculptures enhance nature with elements of art and history and free time in Bellagio where narrow cobbled streets, promenades planted with Oleander and Lime and fin-de-siecle hotels painted in shades of butterscotch, peach and cream, nestle between the waters of Lake Como and the steep slopes of the European Alps. The medieval town itself deserted in the 13th century and has crumbled in to a mystical ruin. You also visit Castel Gandolfo the Pope's 12th century residence and place of escape from the heat of mid-summer Rome. The palace was ceded to the Catholic church to settle

1596 and the gardens were added in 1626. They were restored in 1929 and the scale and perfection of these Imperial gardens is grand even by today's standards. They are impeccably maintained right down to the olive groves, vineyards and Pontifical farm which supplies fresh produce to the Pope's table.

Day 6 Friday 03 May

Rome to Siena

Travel through beautiful Umbria and Tuscany today to the exquisite small city of Siena. On the way you visit a landmark in the history of Italian gardens Villa Lante at Bagnaio. This is a lovely example of a Renaissance garden which has remained unchanged in size and structure since the 16th century. Arranged on four levels along a main axis and emphasized by fountains with perfect symmetry, there are two parts divided by a flowing water parterre forming a water chain. There is a wonderful sense of tranquility here. Join your tour leader this evening for dinner in a local trattoria and the Italian ritual of an evening stroll known as passeggiata. **Overnight Siena** Breakfast • Dinner





Day 7 Saturday 04 May

Montalcino, Bagno Vignoni & Pienza Take a road less travelled through pure Tuscany today delighting in some of the most quintessential Tuscan towns and landscapes. These are the unspoilt gems of the UNESCO Val d'Orcia Natural Park of Cultural and Natural Heritage. Highlights include the idyllic hamlet of Bagno Vignoni on the ancient Via Francigena pilgrimage route to Rome, and delightful Pienza, a small township with a huge papal palace and wonderful old city walls from where you truly have some of the finest vistas in all of Tuscany. Visit the palace, its petite garden and the authentic pedestrian precinct before arriving at the astonishing nearby

alabaster Abbey of Saint Antimo. An absolute jewel of mysticism it is one of the most significant and starkly beautiful Romanesque structures standing today. Home to a small number of Olivetan Benedictine monks Saint Antimo's setting amongst vineyards, Cypress and Poplar trees is picture book. You also explore fabulous hilltop Montalcino noted for its rich red Brunello wines, ancient city walls with breathtaking views, fine cobbled centre and delectable and pastry shops. **Overnight Siena** Breakfast





Siena to Florence

This morning you walk with a guide to appreciate the history and substantial treasures of Siena. See the colossal medieval Cathedral and the Piazza del Campo, Italy's finest and most beautiful central plaza and an idyllic example of cultural and architectural integrity. Continue to Florence to visit the Uffizi Gallery one of the great museums of the world which houses a treasure trove of Italian Renaissance artworks by masters such as Michelangelo, Leonardo da Vinci, Titian, Caravaggio and Botticelli.
